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## **AHP 2009 Round B Opens – Applications Available** **Bulletin No. 0908** **August 5, 2009**

The FHLBI is pleased to announce the opening of the second round of the 2009 Affordable Housing Program (AHP). **Approximately \$ 7.2 million will be available this round.** AHP can be used for the acquisition, purchase or rehabilitation of owner-occupied or rental housing for low- to moderate-income families. Since 1990, FHLBI has committed more than \$161 million in AHP subsidies. Below are some important reminders about the application process.

3. **After the application has been discussed and approved by an FHLBI member financial institution**, complete the *Notification of Intent (NOI)* form and submit it by . The NOI is not required but strongly encouraged.

5. The application and all required exhibits and attachments are due in our office by **5:00 p.m. EDT on September 9, 2009**. Applications not received by the deadline cannot be accepted.
6. Award announcements will be made on or about December 4, 2009. Monitor the website for updates.
