The FHLBI board of directors approved the Implementation Plan at the January meeting.

At this time we are also accepting applications for reservations of our Homeownership Opportunities Program (HOP) funding. To ensure a successful submission:

2. HOPReserve applications may be submitted by an FHLBI member financial institution only. Please note that we can only accept an application with the original **signature** of one of the member's authorized signatories. Applications and any required attachments are due in our office by **5:00 p.m. EST on February 20, 2008**. Applications not received by mail or delivery by the deadline cannot be accepted.
3. Training webinars on how to administer the program will be scheduled late February and early March. **All members that intend to utilize the Homeownership Initiatives are required to participate.** *If the member's primary and/or secondary contact participated in a training webinar in 2007, repeat participation in 2008 is not required.* Training dates will be made available on the [Conferences and Training](#) page of our website in mid-February.
4. HOPReserve award announcements will be made on or about February 29, 2008.
