To All Interested Parties:

Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis (FHLBI) is now accepting nominations for a Michigan member of the Advisory Council on affordable housing and community investment. Nominations can be made by completing and returning the attached form. Nominations must be received by October 17, 2008, to be considered.

Overview

The Affordable Housing Advisory Council is a 12 member Council that meets quarterly to advise representatives of FHLBI's Board of Directors on ways in which FHLBI can better carry out its housing finance and community investment mission, including, but not limited to, advice on the low- and moderate-income housing and community investment programs and needs in FHLBI's district, and on the use of Affordable Housing Program (AHP) subsidies, FHLBI advances, and other credit products for these purposes. Members of the Advisory Council receive a fee for each quarterly bank meeting they attend and are reimbursed for travel, lodging and meal expenses. Meetings may require overnight travel but are usually one day in length. Additional committee meetings may be required.

Requirements

FHLBI must draw nominees from a diverse range of community and non-profit organizations actively involved in providing or promoting low- and moderate-income housing or community lending in the district. Nominees for this vacant position must reside in Michigan.

Terms

Members are appointed for three-year terms, with a maximum of two consecutive terms.
