**Additional Homeownership Initiatives Programs (HOP, NIP, AMP) Funds
Available September 7, 2016**

The Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis (FHLBI) will make the second release of Homeownership Initiative Program funds available on Wednesday, **September 7, 2016**.

Approximately \$1 million will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Only funding requests from FHLBI members that have completed the registration process and a mandatory training webinar will be accepted. We anticipate this round of funding will be exhausted quickly. Please note: Requests received in advance of the release date noted above will be returned to sender.

In partnership with you, FHLBI offers three Homeownership Initiative grant programs that address the needs of families throughout the life cycle of homeownership:

- **Homeownership Opportunities Program (HOP):** Helps first-time homebuyers with down payment assistance.
- **Neighborhood Impact Program (NIP):** Assists low-income homeowners with home repairs.
- **Accessibility Modifications Program (AMP):** Aids seniors and households with disabled family members with home modifications that will allow them to remain in their current homes.
