



## 2020 Disaster Relief Program Affected Counties

In May 2020, the federal government and state of Michigan issued a disaster declaration for five counties and one city in Michigan affected by torrential rain, which caused severe flooding and dam failure.

On June 25, 2020 the FHLBank Indianapolis Board of Directors activated the Disaster Relief Program (“DRP”) with an allocation of \$150,000 for DRP requests to aid homeowners affected by this disaster. Eligible homeowners may request up to \$10,000 in DRP grant funds to make qualified repairs to their primary residence.

**To qualify for DRP funds, a homeowner must reside within one of the following five counties or one city in Michigan with a declared disaster/emergency status.**

Michigan has currently issued disaster/emergency declarations for 5 counties and 1 city:

Arenac, Gladwin, Iosco, Midland, and Saginaw counties, as well as the city of Midland.
